## COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES

- Over the past 10 years, Baker students have had a **90%** acceptance rate to dental school, **72%** acceptance rate to medical school, and **90%** acceptance rate to veterinary school,
- In the fall of 2021, senior business majors scored in the **85th** percentile on the ETS exam, which measures workforce preparedness.
- The Baker Wetlands and Discovery Center offer students **927** acres of diverse natural habitats and lab space and equipment, just a few miles from campus.

## SCHOOL OF NURSING

- School of Nursing NCLEX (licensure exam) first-time pass rates are consistently **above** the Kansas and national level.
- Within three months of obtaining their license, **100%** of Baker graduates that are licensed in Kansas are employed.

## SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

- Over the past 10 years, three Baker grads have won the **Milken Educator Award**, the nation's preeminent teacher recognition program.
- Baker graduates have a **98%** success rate on the licensing exam for principals.

## SCHOOL OF PROFESSIONAL AND GRADUATE STUDIES

- Baker has developed partnerships with **more than 40** area employers to offer a reduction in tuition to their employees.
- Baker's **dual graduate degree program** allows students to take an additional 18 to 24 hours to earn a second master's degree, which increases their career options and earning potential.
